

CIPHI Ontario Branch Award of Excellence for the Dissemination of Public Health Information

Application Criteria

This award recognizes contribution of a CIPHI Ontario Branch public health professional for the dissemination of public health information in the province of Ontario and abroad.

The membership committee will look for original, innovative initiatives with high impact. Research papers including theoretical, policy and research material are included. Eligible recipients are reviewed and selected by the Membership Committee who will then forward applicants to Ontario Branch Executive Council for final approval of selected candidates.

In order to be eligible, the initiative or paper must have been implemented or published in the calendar year prior to the nomination. Nominations, including self-nominations, should include the nomination and a brief letter highlighting the contribution of the initiative. Any research papers must have been published in an English-language peer-reviewed journal and an electronic PDF version of the paper must be submitted with the nomination.

Examples of initiatives could include: the development of a media or training resource, or the creation and/or enhancement of a website.

Criteria:

- a)** Must be a member in good standing for the two consecutive years prior to their application in order to receive the award of excellence.
- b)** Must have made a significant contribution to the environmental health profession must be demonstrated through achievement or milestone event (e.g. Work in a Master's program, significant contribution to a public health unit impacting the greater community) and through the applicant's professional profile within the field of public health.

Application Process:

- a)** The nominator must complete the attached application form and submit it to the Membership Support and Engagement Councillor (membership@ciphi.on.ca).
- b)** The significant contribution must have occurred within the calendar year prior to award application.
- c)** The nominator must provide supplemental information (e.g. testimonials) to verify significant contribution to environmental health through an achievement or milestone event and through the applicant's professional profile in the field of public health.
- d)** Letters of support from the broader public health community supporting the impact of the achievement are encouraged.
- e)** Describe the achievement and explain, in plain language, why the achievement was above and beyond the nominee's regular work. Note that extra materials such as publications, brochures and videos *should not* be submitted.
- f)** The membership committee will review the applications. Nominee(s) will be contacted within 30 days of the application deadline.

Remittance of Award:

- a)** The award letter, trophy and plaque for the CIPHI Ontario Branch Award of Excellence for the Dissemination of Public Health Information will be awarded the AGM and presented at the Awards luncheon during the provincial annual educational conference.
